

Attached is a memorandum from Paul Sheldon, Director of Public Works, requesting authorization to amend the 2024 Capital Budget for the replacement of three (3) tandem plow trucks and (3) single axle plow trucks. Mr. Sheldon indicates that the increased costs associated with steel and the manufacturing and delivery of vehicle components.

2020 leftover Capital Project Dump Truck Funds and an additional ask of \$113,377 to cover the overages for the new (6) trucks are requested from the Legislature. The County's snowplow equipment supplier, Tenco, has fortunately informed the Department of Public Works that they can possibly provide all six plow trucks December 2024, as opposed to the usual 18-month lead time.

The attached memorandum from Jaclyn Falotico, Commissioner of Finance, details the necessary budget amendment.

SUBJECT: Fleet Budget Amedment

The 2023 and 2024 budget allocation for the Department of Engineering and Public Works snowFleet incorporates the replacement of three (3) tandem plow trucks and (3) single axie plow trucks, aimed at updating our aging plow truck fleet. Our existing snowplow fleet primarily comprises International trucks, fostering a favorable relationship with the manufacturer and dealers during both the procurement and maintenance phases. However, given the heightened demand and constrained supply of these vehicles, order banks for 2023 have already closed, and a similar scenario may unfold in 2024. Despite our efforts to explore alternative truck manufacturers, we encounter either the same challenges or costs exceeding our budget constraints.

Recently, our snowplow equipment supplier, Tenco, informed us of a turnkey agreement with International. This arrangement enables Tenco to directly acquire trucks from International and then customize them for our snowplow operations. Tenco has a limited allocation of trucks, and they anticipate rapid depletion of this allocation. They have provided quotes for all six plow vehicles required for both last year's and this year's budgets. Notably, Tenco offers a swift delivery timeline, with the possibility of trucks arriving as early as this December, in stark contrast to the 18+ month lead times associated with other dealers.

Tenco also highlighted that the costs of trucks have seen a significant surge due to increased steel prices and escalating manufacturing and delivery expenses for vehicle components. The County currently earmarks \$860,000.00 in the 2023 capital budget and another \$860,000.00 in the 2024 budget for a total of \$1,720,000.00 to cover the acquisition of three plow trucks each year. However, Tenco's quote for all six trucks, including plows and dump bodies, amounts to \$1,860,513.00. Additionally, we need to factor in the costs of equipping all six pieces of equipment with auto-chains and radios, which adds an extra \$42,840.00 to the overall vehicle expenses.



The six trucks slated for replacement have an average age of almost 14 years. In the previous year alone, these trucks necessitated over \$120,000.00 in repairs to ensure their roadworthiness for another winter season. The imperative to replace our vehicle fleet is driven by the essential need to maintain coverage for our 21 plow routes, encompassing State and County Roads. Ensuring the reliability of our winter maintenance operations and addressing the mounting repair costs make the timely replacement of these trucks a crucial step in sustaining the effectiveness of our snowplow services.
