Project Description:

This project includes the construction and construction administration/inspection for the reconstruction of the General Aviation (GA) North Apron and adjacent jug-handle taxi lane.

Reconstruction of the existing apron's asphalt (550ft x 250ft) and jug-handle taxi lane (850ft x 45ft) includes full-depth removal of the existing pavement section (asphalt and subbase stone), replacement of new structural subbase, crushed aggregate base course and bituminous asphalt paving. This project also includes the repair/maintenance of existing drainage, installation of a new storm water retention structure for climate resiliency and reconstruction of apron lighting, security gate access and placement of Federal Aviation Administration(FAA) required pavement markings.

Justification:

The associated apron and taxi lane have exceeded their 20-year design life while also degrading to an average Pavement Condition Index (PCI) of approximately 17-20 (serious). A PCI is a rating from 0 (failed) to 100 (new), the current condition of the asphalt risks damage to any aircraft that travels over it under their own power. This is the final section of the airports existing asphalt that hasn't been upgraded within the last 20 years. Once this is completed, the average PCI rating of the airport will be 85+ (good-new). With a reconstruction project, New York State Department of Transportation and the FAA require a percentage of the asphalt be treated as new for storm water purposes. This is to reduce down stream runoff and flooding potential caused by increased rain events.

Project Description:

Construction of a new airport maintenance storage building to house maintenance equipment during the winter months. The building will be approximately 100 feet long by 25 feet deep.

Justification:

The airport mowers are currently stored in an old storage building between Taxiway "E" and the properties along Habel Lane. The County is in the process of amending our lease with the Air National Guard to expand their current leased area. The 911 Center uses Pulsiam CAD/RMS to dispatch for all Police, Fire and EMS agencies in the County. This product that we use was adopted when the UCC was formed. The program that the UCC uses for CAD dispatch is called Hiterm. This product is no longer being supported and we are being forced to use what we believe is a far less user-friendly system. There are only 3 agencies left in the entire state using this software as other options have far more capabilities. We have started demos for other vendor products and see immediate benefits to making a change. There will be a costs-sharing conversation that will need to happen as the City and Towns pay for the UCC also, however the initial Capital budget will need to go through the County Process.

Justification:

Our current product is no longer being supported so a change is needed. The intent here is to adopt one standardized CAD/RMS for the entire County to use. New systems are far more user-friendly which will cut down the lengthy training process for new hire dispatchers, provide immediate officer safety information that our current system does not, and standardize the county for information sharing purposes.
