All proposals must be delivered in a sealed envelope marked "Bid" and stating Schenectady County Roofing projects, RFB-2023-48, to the Director of Purchasing, no later than June 29, 2023 at 2:00 PM at which time they will be opened.

Bid Security shall be submitted with each bid as described in General Instructions to Bidders.

Schenectady County will make any investigation it deems necessary to determine the responsibility of any bidder to perform the work.
